Ausdauer und Enthusiasmus haben AUXAN und seiner Organisation geholfen, im Laufe der Zeit Fortschritte zu erzielen.



Dank der unschätzbarer Hilfe von Philippe, ehrenamtlicher Buchhalter von AUXAN, konnten wir im Herbst 2018 eine detaillierte und aktuelle Aufstellung der finanziellen Unterstützung an Verbände zur Verfügung stellen.

Hier sind 3 Diagramme unserer Finanzen:




- **Animal rescue** **94.95%**
- **Events** **4.44%**
- **Administration fees** **0.61%**

AUXAN's main aim is to ensure that all donations received are effectively redistributed almost entirely to trusted, struggling organisations.

Note that the President, Jennifer, and the Secretary, Pascale, are both volunteer members.

As can be seen, **95% of donations received in cash are redistributed to animal welfare associations in Switzerland and abroad**; we strive to minimise all expenses (e.g. accounting, website management, administration fees, etc.) so that the sums given to other associations can continue to increase.

Funding received between 2013 and 2018 amounted to a total of: **57 554 CHF**.

In Switzerland we are often asked the following question: "How much do you hand out within Switzerland?" We have donated **15.17%** to organisations in Switzerland. The main difficulty we face is that when an organisation in Switzerland needs financial support, the sums involved are often too high for our resources. For example, with 200 CHF, we can buy several hundred kilos of dry food for a shelter in Romania that has nothing left to feed 400 dogs with. In Switzerland, with the same sum we can cover a visit to the vet and some aftercare for 1 animal. We strictly control all purchases of food and equipment, as well as expenses, by requesting receipts for all work carried out.


Rest assured that we will be able to provide more realistic help within Switzerland with more donors and more resources. Patience, patience!

The funding received makes it possible to buy food, medical equipment, pay veterinary bills, cover the current expenses of a shelter in severe difficulty (electricity, heating, etc.); everything directly or indirectly related to the survival and welfare of animals.

AUXAN would also like to take this opportunity to thank all the veterinarians who support our work by offering discounts, especially our designated veterinarian Dr. Marc-Alain Tièche, Veterinary Clinic of Gottaz, Morges, for his support and trust from the very start of this adventure.

Besides the account initially opened at PostFinance, in 2018 we opened a bank account at Credit Suisse on behalf of AUXAN, to reduce the transfer costs of financial transactions to foreign organisations.

Thanks to the one-off partnerships (with suppliers of medical equipment and/ or laboratories for humans and/ or animals in Switzerland, France/ Belgium, such as Medtronic, Biokema, Vetoquinol, Merck, Districlub Medical, V-Trade, Inselspital Bem, etc.) or to long-term partnerships (such as with the Fondation Genolier), we are able to secure a maximum amount of new, single use medical materials, medical equipment (e.g. apparatus) or office equipment (e.g. to equip veterinary clinics).

Between 2013 and 2018, we redistributed medical equipment with a total value of: 630 514 CHF.

Our top priority is to provide quality materials and equipment to treat animals in the best possible conditions. A stray dog that is to be sterilised in India will only see a veterinarian once in its life, and won't be returning to have the stitches removed. It is with great pride that since 2013, we have donated over **200 surgical suture kits** (36 units/ box), which have allowed over **7000 animals** to be operated on and sterilised - mainly cats and dogs, as well as equines (e.g. work horses and/ or donkeys)

The main difficulty lies in storing these supplies in suitable conditions, and transporting and delivering the material and products to the various shelters. The logistics and transport side is onerous and complex: a full time job by itself! To ensure that small items aren't blocked at customs, or subject to kick-backs, we sometimes go through trusted persons to send such small items directly to the shelter concerned; this is done on a case by case basis.

Conference on Assistance Dogs in Switzerland

In collaboration with the Swiss association "Farah Dogs", we organised a Discovery Conference, open to the general public and professionals, on medical assistance/ support dogs on Sunday, November 18, 2018, at Foyer Beausobre in Morges.

Thanks to the invaluable support we received, this event was a resounding success. The excellent standard of the speakers and the presentations they made allowed us to cover a range of topics related to assistance dogs, engaging the audience on scientific, clinical, medical, social, economic and legal themes.

We welcomed 160 participants, with a very diverse audience including many professionals (vets, doctors, nurses, educators, etc.).




Les Granolas de Jenny : news 2018

We are pleased with the sales success of Les Granolas de Jenny, a premium, crunchy gluten-free muesli (for humans!) produced in Switzerland, where all profits are ploughed back to the animals through AUXAN.

Originally, AUXAN's hope was to try to generate its own profits through the sale of a product to feed the association's coffers, over and above private or legacy donations; the aim being thus to have greater autonomy and to avoid dependence purely on donations to finance protection societies for distressed animals in the medium/ long term.



Foster family & adoptions in Switzerland

While the AUXAN association has neither material resources nor the aim of replacing animal welfare organisations such as shelters, we do under exceptional circumstances take in a few animals in critical emergency situations, such as cats and dogs at risk, and only where we are able to find a foster family.

Number of animals re-homed and adopted:

Since its creation, AUXAN has managed to home with host families and adopt out 13 animals (3 dogs, 10 cats); with 5 of these adopted in 2018.

Over and above the support work in these four fields, here are some of our projects for 2019:

- ✓ Promote the AUXAN Association and Les Granolas de Jenny via social media (e.g. Facebook, Instagram) to reach new donors
- ✓ Extend our network so that we can continue to connect associations and/ or people involved in animal welfare with the most appropriate natural or legal persons
- ✓ Create new marketing materials (e.g. bilingual Auxan presentation brochure)

- ✓ Set up a mailshot to foundations in Switzerland to request financial support
- ✓ Approach companies/ laboratories to secure donations in the form of medical supplies and/ or food for struggling shelters
- ✓ Establish partnerships with local logistics providers to collect, store and dispatch forthcoming donations of materials and/ or food (e.g. transport companies, storage units, etc.)
